2. **First Day of School** -Tuesday August 27, 2024 (½ Day) from 9:10 a.m.-12:20 p.m.
3. **Second Day of School** -Wednesday August 28, 2024 (Full Day) from 9:10 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
4. **Third Day of School** -Thursday August 29, 2024 (Full Day) from 9:10 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
5. **NO SCHOOL**-Friday August 30, 2024
6. **NO SCHOOL**-Monday September 2, 2024
7. **School resumes**-Tuesday September 3, 2024 (Full Day) 9:10 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
8. **For the first week ONLY:** Kindergarten and First Grade parents may walk their child to the classroom beginning on Monday September 9, 2024, all students must be dropped off at the front doors for grades K-1 and at the gym doors for grades 2-5. Staff will escort students to their classrooms. Parents must sign-in, obtain a visitors badge in the office and have permission to be in the building to ensure we have a safe school environment.

PARKING LOT: Parents and Guardians, when dropping off or picking up a child from school, you **MUST** park in a parking space or continue to loop around, **THERE IS NO PARKING** in the looping area.
